Sample Activities



<p>Hide objects in a box & let your toddler pull them out & name them. It's best to target some of the first early words that most children say. Some of these words include car, cat, dog, cookie, mama, daddy, hat, book, shoes, and socks.</p>	<p>Target the early speech sound /b/. Find objects and pictures that start with this sound. For example, you can point out and talk about the following objects and pictures: , ball, book, baby, bubbles, banana, etc.</p>	<p>Play cars with your toddler. Say "ready, set" and get your toddler to say "go" when rolling it on the floor. Try to get your toddler to say & imitate "beep-beep", "my turn", "your turn" during play.</p>	<p>Teach your toddler to clean up his toys. Say "open" as you open the toy box and "in" as your toddler puts toys in the toy box. Try to get him/her to repeat the words open and in as you're helping him/her clean up. Teach your toddler a clean up song</p>	<p>Play hide and seek with your toddler while targeting basic concepts (on, in, under, behind, etc). Hide in different places around your house. When your toddler finds you say, "You found me _____ (behind the chair, under the table, on the couch, etc.)"</p>
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
